## **Academic Regulations**

This takes place primarily through the Christian ethos of preferring one another, demonstrated through collaboration and humility, but is also facilitated through structures and systems that are designed to promote success. The regulations below outline:

- How assessments and examinations take place
- What to do if you need to retake or resit a module
- What awards are available and how they are calculated, including your degree classification
